

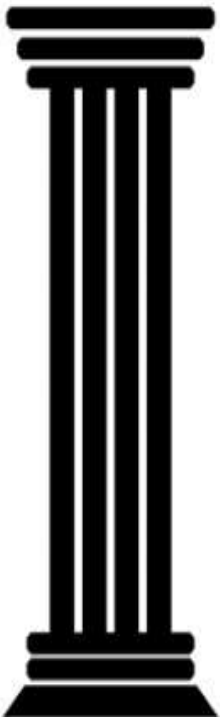

## Important Announcements

- **SBAC English & Math testing for juniors will continue this week until Friday, June 1<sup>st</sup>.** Juniors will be tested in small groups and have received their specific testing date during their Junior Seminar class. (Woodley)
- There are two weeks remaining in the school year, including final benchmark exams. **Let's finish the school year strong!** (Woodley)
- **Students who received a Credit Recovery Recommendation letter for Summer 2018** must turn in their Acknowledgement Form to Mrs. Mendoza no later than June 1<sup>st</sup>. (Mendoza)
- **Journalism club will be meeting every Thursday at lunch and after school** in Mr. Cruz's class (Room 305). Please bring your stories and ideas. (Cruz)
- **Eligible students will be allowed to have off-campus lunch on Fridays. Criteria:** 1) 600+ Stock points 2) No fails 3) No tardies or trancies for the week 4) Must be in appropriate school uniform everyday 5) Approval required from all teachers. **Instructions:** Eligible students must pick up an off-campus lunch request form/permission slip from the main office each week that they wish to have lunch off-campus. - **All juniors who are taking the June 2<sup>nd</sup> SAT** must be on time and bring their printed ticket, current photo ID, number 2 pencils, and approved calculator to their testing site on the day of the exam. - **Senior students must be good standing in order to participate in senior activities, including prom and the graduation ceremony. Good senior standing criteria:** 1) No fails. 2) No credit recovery courses. 3) Minimum 80 stock points. (Mendoza)
- **Seniors who will need final transcripts sent to their college/university** must complete a transcript request form prior to their last day of school in order for transcripts to be sent. Request forms are located outside of the counseling room (room 306) and should be returned to Mrs. Mendoza. Please note, transcripts will not be sent if the student has a remaining account balance. Transcripts will be released once all school balances have been paid. (Mendoza)
- **All seniors who were awarded a Cal-Grant** must create a WebGrants 4 Students account and confirm their School of Attendance in order for funds to be distributed to their college/university in the fall.
