

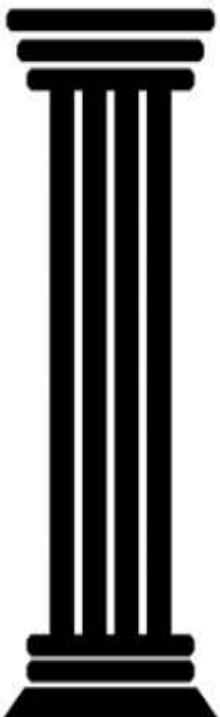

Important Announcements

- **SBAC English & Math testing for juniors begins this week and will continue until Friday, June 1st.** Juniors will be tested in small groups and should have received their specific testing date during their Junior Seminar class. (Woodley)
- **Students who received a Credit Recovery Recommendation letter for Summer 2018** must turn in their Acknowledgement Form to Mrs. Mendoza no later than June 1st. (Mendoza)

- **Eligible students will be allowed to have off-campus lunch on Fridays. Criteria:** 1) 600+ Stock points 2) No fails 3) No tardies or truancies for the week 4) Must be in appropriate school uniform everyday 5) Approval required from all teachers. **Instructions:** Eligible students must pick up an off-campus lunch request form/permission slip from the main office each week that they wish to have lunch off-campus.
